## Dare to believe

Greg Laurie, a current Christian author and speaker, shares some valuable words of hope over this Easter season.

"Easter is not about brightly coloured eggs, wearing pastels, or enjoying a big meal, although it could include these. Easter is about the death and resurrection of Jesus Christ.

For some, Easter will be a great day, spent surrounded by family and friends. But for others, it will be a sad day, because Easter is a reminder of a loved one who has died and is now desperately missed.

Death seems so cruel, so harsh, and so final. That is what the disciples were feeling when they saw their Lord, whom they had left everything to follow, hanging on the cross. They were devastated. Death had crushed them. But if they would have gone back in their memories, they would have recalled an important event and statement Jesus had made.

They would have remembered Jesus standing at the tomb of his close friend Lazarus. They would have remembered that Jesus did something completely unexpected: He wept (see John 11:35). Jesus wept, because He knew that death was not part of God's original plan. Humanity was not meant to grow old, to suffer with disease, or to die. But because of the sin of Adam and Eve, sin entered the human race, and death followed with it. And death spread to all of us. Jesus wept, because it broke His heart.

But standing there at Lazarus' tomb, Jesus also delivered these hope-filled words: "I am the resurrection and the life. He who believes in Me, though he may die, he shall live" (John 11:25). Death is not the end. And the resurrection of Jesus Christ proves it.

If you have put your faith in Christ, then Easter means that you will live forever in the presence of God. Easter brings hope to the person who has been devastated by death."

The hope of Easter can be yours both now and for all time. Will you dare to believe, that Jesus came to die for you, and to make it possible for you to live in a right relationship with him? Like those at that first Easter, there is unmatched joy to be found by any who choose not to doubt, but to trust in the risen lord Jesus Christ.

Those who do, soon discover why we say Good Friday and Happy Easter. They discover the the greatest love story ever told. And the good news is-it's no fairy tale, but witnessed reality. Go on - dare to believe this Easter season.

## No power like it!

Jesus had told his disciples of the Spirit of truth "whom I shall send to you." John 15.26. Sure enough, after Christ's rising from the dead, it happened.

**First**, earlier the disciples lacked spiritual power (Matthew 17.16). Now "with great power the apostles gave witness to the resurrection of the Lord Jesus." Acts 4.33.

**Second**, before Christ's resurrection, the disciples were asking questions. Matthew 24.3, Mark 4.10, Luke 8.25, John 9.2, etc. Now they were answering questions. Acts 4.7; 5.29; 7.1; 9.30-31.

**Third**, beforehand they had disputed among themselves, Luke 9.46. Now they had all things in common. Acts 2.44.

**Fourth**, in the Gospels we see Jesus quoting the holy Scriptures. Matthew 4.1-10, etc. But now it's the disciples doing it. Acts 2.16; 3.22-25; 4.25-26.

**Fifth**, the Gospels show only Jesus staying awake to pray. Matthew 26.40. But in Acts 4.24-31 we see the disciples engaged in powerful prayer.

So what made such a difference? They now had the promised indwelling presence of God's Holy Spirit. The Holy Spirit will enable us too to do what nothing else can – make people aware of the wonderful, living, transforming presence of our Creator God.

What empowers Christians? "The Holy Spirit, whom God has given to those who obey him." Acts 5.32 (NIV).
