This year we come to the 10th year anniversary of a great dream realised. 10 years ago our dream was to widen the influence of the newly developed "Lifewell Ministries" whose heart was to deal with the real life issues deeply impacting our communities, churches and individual lives. Lifewell had seen many come to discover *wholeness* in Jesus' name. *Transforming* change was being seen through a model of ministry grounded deeply within the life and service of the local church. Now it was time to create a platform from which to *announce and champion* the calling of the local church to be a restoring faith community. It was time for the wider Church to be challenged to go to the *deeper* places, where people needed release from burdens, habits, hang ups and addictive patterns that were blocking them from living life well.



And so LIFE WELL CONFERENCE was birthed.

The conference initially became a window into the focus and mission of LifeWell, as a unique faith based service centre of Enfield Baptist Church Inc which helped people live life well through access to high quality care and recovery services for the whole Person (Emotional, Physical, Spiritual realms) delivered on an individual & small group model. LifeWell recognised the biblical call for Jesus' followers to be involved in his big agenda to restore 'all things' under Christ Jesus (Col 1:20) and:

Luke 4:18 (NIV) "The Spirit of the Lord ...has anointed me
to bring good news to the poor. He has sent me to proclaim freedom for the
prisoners and recovery of sight for the blind, to release the oppressed,

Here Jesus underlined one of the most basic realities about life – that He came to restore the broken and bring recovery and healing to the hurting. So, when Jesus called us to be his followers, in a process of *discipleship*, his mandate became ours.

As Lifewell conference grew in size and influence it formed its own distinct DNA as a restorative influence aimed to *equip and empower*: - people generally to navigate personal and relational challenges and deal effectively with the pressures and demands of life; Community Service Professionals to increase in knowledge and expand networks to keep doing great work at the grass-roots level; and Pastors and Leaders to support the church and community in the deeper issues of living life well.

Now is the time to make sure the 10th year is a great celebration. Support it with everything you can. This starts with **registering** as soon as possible to be there yourself, and be active in inviting others, and offering to serve in the many opportunities which exist in such a conference.

It is yet to be determined what the nature and shape of conference will be for 2017. Whatever, it will be *different*. **This year is the last or an era**. Be sure you get on board and help make this the best conference ever for the good and glory of God to whom we say our heartfelt thanks for designing this conference in heaven and entrusting it to us on earth.

Is God real?

If we can't see, hear, or touch him, how in the world does God communicate with us?

First, he is *personal*. In the opening pages of his Book, God is seen dealing personally with mankind. This carries right through to the New Testament where, to our amazement, he presences himself amongst us in the person of Jesus Christ.

Second, he is *authoritative*. Though we would deny it, we love being told by experts, opinion leaders, and authority figures what to think. And because what God says makes sense, millions of Christians delight in being shown, in his Book, exactly how he wants us to think.

Third, he is *credible*. God is knowledgeable about our world. His Book has no statements that are nonsensical, unhistorical, or plainly wrong. (The miracles of Jesus simply apply laws of nature which we have not yet discovered).

Fourth, he is *authentic*. His Book is not a hoax. Its long-established record of human history is thoroughly in accord with the wide-spread discoveries made by archaeologists in Bible lands.

Down the ages believers have found God's every word trustworthy and an essential guide for living a successful life in our troubled world.

Our God is real indeed.

God says, "I am the Lord, and there is no other; apart from me there is no God" Isaiah 45.5 (NIV).

His claim stands unchallenged.
