Wanting Jesus More

One of the ways we describe our church community is that we are *engaged* and *passionate* followers of Jesus. While this is a statement of *aspiration* in our planning materials, could it become a more *real* and *growing* 'actual' in our lives? Are you seeing a growing desire for *knowing* more of Jesus and *following* him more fully? Are you seeing a growing *engagement* with this body of believers you call your spiritual home? Are you finding yourself drawn to seek out more ways you can *serve* Jesus in and through this church? Are you finding that you are developing good *spiritual habits* of prayer, study and fellowship? Jesus calls us to *follow* him. This has radical consequences and calls for *daring faith* in the face of the culture we live in.

Over this month we will consider some of the hero's of daring faith both in the Bible story, and in the history of the Christian movement - but we would also love to hear *your* story of taking daily steps to follow Jesus and make him known.

At the end of this month - June 26th there will be a **Baptism** service. This is one specific way you can grow in your walk with Jesus - by following his *command* to be baptised. This is a step *every* follower is asked by Jesus to take. The biblical pattern is *believers* baptism meaning that baptism follows faith. It is an outward expression of an inward transformation. It is a living picture of what Jesus has done to gain your salvation. It is also an act of submission and surrender to Jesus as you proclaim him to be the rightful Lord of your life. I would love to chat with you more about being baptised. The water will be warm and deep enough for you - so let me know.

One engaged passionate follower of Jesus was Francis of Assisi. It was said of him "He shone in his days as a morning star in the midst of the clouds." I wonder - what might be said of us? Francis did not seek glory and fame for himself—he shunned it. More than anything else, Francis wanted simply **to be like Jesus**. As he put it in the Rule of 1221, the aim of his life was "to live in obedience, in chastity and without property, following the teaching and footsteps of our Lord Jesus Christ."

Beyond doubt, Francis was a Jesus-saturated saint. As Thomas of Celano said: "He was always *occupied* with Jesus; Jesus he bore in his heart, Jesus in his mouth, Jesus in his ears, Jesus in his eyes, Jesus in his hands, Jesus in the rest of his members."

There is a famous story that Jesus once appeared to Francis and said to him: "You are mad, Francis." To which the saint replied: "Not so much as you are, Lord." In ALL things he wanted Jesus to be *more*. Francis knew that to follow Jesus deliberately and seriously was to appear foolish before the wisdom of the world.

As we consider the *actuals* of being an engaged and passionate follower of Jesus, I encourage you to come along *each* week to share in worship, fellowship, and learning - as we recognise how *good* it is to *gather, grow and go* together, as those who follow Jesus fully and flourish through his life planted within us.
