## THE DAY OF PENTECOST: A NEW CREATION - A NEW COMMUNITY - A NEW CELEBRATION

"Genesis 1 starts with a scene of utter chaos. Thick darkness covers formless void. **Then, the Spirit of God hovers over the face of the deep** and God brings *order* to unfathomable chaos. God speaks meaning into being; ordered purpose displaces formless void. This is the dawn of creation whose yield we remember from time to time in harvest festivals and other celebrations of nature.

Each year, we also remember the act of God at the dawn of the new creation. Frightened people huddled together in an Upper Room, experience a new eruption of the Holy Spirit's power to inaugurate a new creation. **The Spirit moves over the face of another chaotic situation and brings into being a new order.** Through Peter, God announces Good News of the salvation made possible through the risen Lord, and the church develops a deep consciousness of itself. Or, as we love to put it, the church comes into being.

**This is the reason we celebrate at Pentecost:** God does not abandon disordered creation. God renews the creation and opens wide the door to new life for all who ask, "What are we to do?" Hearing God's answer, our hearts are enlightened and we find the wisdom to say, "We now turn. We now repent." Then, we plunge into the soothing waters for incorporation into Christ.

Baptized in the name of the triune God, we experience the miraculous power of the one who makes *all things new*. God places eternity in our hearts. We discover not only the renewal of our identity as individuals. We also encounter the depth and breadth of the gift of relationality that is ours. Together with others, we now have the joy of participating in a new community. Baptized in water, we experience the descent of the same Spirit who was with Jesus at the River Jordan.

The Holy Spirit leads us to repent of sin and turn to God in Christ and we experience the promised new creation. We share in the new humanity that God brings into being. This new community is caught up in the purposes of God; it is an important instrument in God's hand to light up the world with the Gospel message and to fill the earth with the glory of God."

In these beautiful words, Neville Callam, the Baptist World Alliance leader, sums up the significance of Pentecost. While it *is* a time of celebration for the new community, it is fore-mostly a time where power was assigned to *communicate* the good news of Jesus. Recent research has shown that people are more open to have dialogue about spiritual matters than we might imagine. They are interested in *your* encounter with Jesus and the lives of authentic followers of Jesus generally. Be alert to being *light and salt* in a dark and tasteless world. People are still open to hear good news. Pentecost provided the power you need to tell others of Jesus and his love for a broken humanity and world.

Note: Pentecost Sunday is the day of the [Pentecost](#) festival, a prominent feast in the calendar of Ancient Israel celebrating the giving of the Law on Sinai, and later in the Christian year, commemorating the descent of the Holy Spirit upon the remaining eleven disciples of Christ (Judas had hanged himself) after the Resurrection of Jesus. It always falls on the seventh Sunday after [Easter](#). Pentecost means "fiftieth day": it is celebrated 50 days from [Easter Sunday](#) (including Easter Sunday in the counting), hence its name. **In 2017 Pentecost Sunday is June 4th**

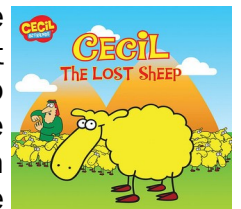
## Stamp Ministry—REMEMBER EVERY STAMP COUNTS!

## God's greatest gift

Does God really love us no matter who we are or what we have done?

Yes, he does, and the fact that he chooses to love us to that extent is by no means as “way out” as we might think. Surely our own love for one another is totally inadequate if it is conditional.

For example, if parental warmth, praise, and affection depend (are conditional) upon a child's good grades at school, imagine how starved of love a poor achiever will be.

Just suppose that God's love for us was conditional upon our performance. Since we well know our own inadequacies, how could we ever believe that he really loves us?

Through Jesus he tells us instead, “I will never refuse anyone who comes to me.” John 6.37 (Phillips Modern English). This shifts the emphasis away from our achieving and focuses on his loving.

God's love has never been on the basis that we have some worth that he can exploit. As the Bible says, true love “does not pursue selfish advantage.” 1 Corinthians 13.5 (Phillips Modern English).

As his love for us is without reserve, shouldn't our response be without reserve too?
