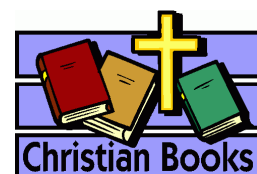

Children and Nature

Research indicates that children who spend lots of time interacting with the natural environment show significant improvement in their academic achievement, self esteem, problem solving and motivation to learn.

Children are calmer, more optimistic, more focused, healthier, more creative and more successful at school when they spend time outdoors.

During the recent summer holidays with my extended family I observed again the fascination of my great-grandchildren with little crabs under rocks, squid catches on the jetty, butterflies floating on the breeze, small insects on twigs, and the variety of under-sea life when they were snorkelling.

I believe such interaction with nature – whether building sandcastles on the beach, collecting rocks, viewing birds, or gardening at home – balances a child's life.

So what about over-fascination with TV, computers and video games? The American Paediatric Association finds these are less helpful, recommending that children under age two have no screen time at all!

Why turn off the screens and get children outdoors? Because God has done such a fabulous job in creating a world full of wonder.

Why should our children miss all this stuff, miss the meaningful interaction available to them, miss all the delights of creative input and stimulating conversation?
