Encountering Jesus

Jesus says, “I am the way, the truth, and the life. No man comes to the Father but by me.” Does this sound narrow-minded? We should not dismiss it for that reason.

First, a compass is narrow-minded – it always points to the magnetic north. Airmen and sailors don't see that as a bad thing. On the contrary, they are glad that the compass is not broadminded.

Second, mathematics is also very narrow-minded. The sum of two plus two is four – never three-and-a-half.

Third, geometry is narrow-minded. It says that a straight line is the shortest distance between two points. But who would say that is an arrogant or intolerant statement?

Fourth, Jesus showed that spiritual issues are equally certain and recognisable. He readily convinces us of the reality of who he is – God's true Messiah.

Early in his relationship with his first disciples he convinced them of this, even though they didn't have all the evidence we have today. Is it narrow-minded to believe the truth? Of course not. And Jesus said, “If any of you really determines to do God's will, then you will certainly know whether my teaching is from God or is merely my own.”
