Jesus, a borrower!

Jesus was born in a borrowed manger, taught from a borrowed boat, entered Jerusalem on a borrowed donkey, ate the Last Supper in a borrowed upper room, and was buried in a borrowed tomb.

Notice, **first**, though Jesus had thousands of angels at his instant disposal (Matthew 26.53), they couldn't identify with weak humanity. To their amazement, he chose to do that himself.

How easy for us to overlook his humility, his grace, his willingness to keep his divine might and power out of sight as he borrowed our human weakness - "became flesh and dwelt among us." John 1.14.

Second, though all authority in heaven and earth belongs to him, Matthew 28.18, he uses *volunteer* labourers as his messengers to the world!

He "borrows" them to help him identify with the poor, the broken-hearted, the captives, the oppressed. Luke 4.18. And Jesus' humble method works. Because people recognise genuine love when they see it, they are drawn not by his awesome power but by his love.

Third, though Jesus knew the Old Testament prophecy - that he would be "despised and rejected of men" Isaiah 53.3 - he was not deterred. And the result? He nevertheless draws multitudes to himself.

Has he drawn you?
